- Notes from July’s Council meeting:**
- Council members spent time in prayer and Bible reading, discussing topics such as fasting and earthly/heavenly treasures.
 - The council welcomed Jonah Uilk to membership at Bethel after he made his profession of faith to the council members.
 - Council received an update from the Pastoral Search Committee.
 - To increase their understanding of CRCNA Church Order, articles 6-7 were read and discussed. These articles give information on the process for ministers being admitted in the CRC.
 - Council members discussed the CRC’s publication, *The Banner*. Specifically they noted that its mandate was changed at Synod 2025. In the past, *The Banner* was a publication for the purpose of sharing diverse viewpoints in order to foster dialogue. The new mandate focuses on representing the CRC publicly, speaking from a distinctly Reformed perspective, and upholding the denomination's confessions and synodical decisions.
 - The deacons, elders and Pastor Marlin gave reports on their ministry work from the past month.

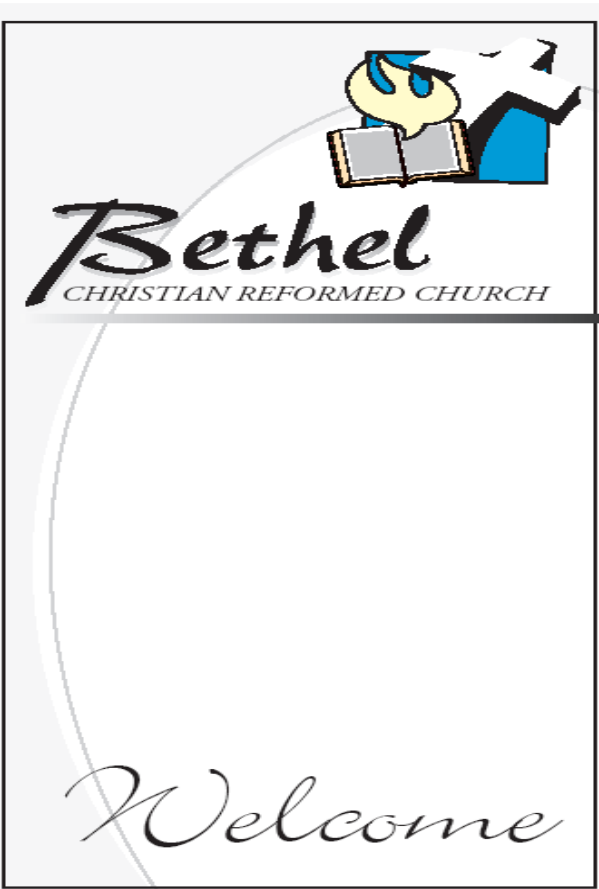
